From the Desk of Father Raaser

I can't believe that I am here writing about Thanksgiving. But ready or not, Thanksgiving Day is this Thursday. It is a time of celebrating our abundance of setting aside a special day to remember where all good things actually comes from and to give thanks to our God for it. As all of the current Prefaces of the Eucharistic Prayer in the Mass begin with "**It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation to give you thanks**, very beautiful and true words. It is our duty, our solemn obligation to give God continual thanks. Giving God thanks is truly proper and what we His creatures, His children owe Him, His due.

Have you noticed that grateful people are happy people, and ungrateful people cannot be happy? We tend to think that it is being unhappy that leads people to complain, but it is the other way around; it is complaining that leads to people becoming unhappy. Become grateful and you will become a much happier person. Work to the point of life, when you see even your crosses as moments of thankfulness and praise.

This is why our faith puts such emphasis on thanking God. The liturgy is filled with expressions of gratitude. Learning to be consistently thankful, whether to God or to other people, is hard to do. Like most useful skills, it takes years of practice before it becomes second nature. Religion, sincerely practiced, leads to happiness - it ingrains the habits of thankfulness. People who thank God before each meal, for example, inculcate gratitude in them. In so doing, they open the door to gladness.

In Hebrew, the word for gratitude - hoda'ah - is the same as the word for praise, and confession. To be thankful will necessarily lead us to praise God; to be thankful lifts us up from this world unto the next. It also makes us confess dependence, on others, to admit that our life is better because of their efforts.

Be thankful. Don't take the gifts in your life for granted. Remember - as the Pilgrims remembered - that we are impoverished without each other, and without God. Whoever and wherever you are this Thanksgiving, the good in your life outweighs the bad.

So, we who have been blessed with the Catholic faith, have the best expression of being thankful, Eucharist-a Greek word that means thanksgiving, so the best way to be thankful to is come to **Mass on Thanksgiving Day. We will have Mass this Thursday morning at 9:00AM.** I ask that you bring a bit of food from your table, the food will be blessed and bring home the blessing to your house and family. Have a good Thanksgiving and be mindful and say a prayer for those less fortunate. Also, we pray for all those traveling this weekend. May God protect their going forth and coming home.

And I shall remember all of you as well at Mass for I'm grateful to you for your goodness, your example of faith and generosity.

Readings for Next Sunday

OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

First Reading: Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17 This passage beautifully describes how the Lord God, as shepherd, will tend his flock. He will rescue those who are lost, bring back those who stray, heal the sick, & “pasture” all.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:20-26, 28 Paul once again stresses the significance of Christ’s resurrection in the total divine plan, emphasizing that Christ’s rising means that those who believe in him will also rise after death. Christianity, he argues, is meaningless if it concerns only this life on earth. In the end, even death will be destroyed, and “God will be all in all.”

Gospel: Matthew 25:31-46 With words both poetic and vivid, Jesus tells the disciples that since he is present in all people, whatever they do to “one of my least brothers” they do to him; and whatever they fail to do to his “least,” they fail to do to him.

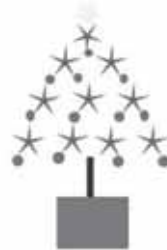
