From the Desk of Father Raaser

Today is *Gaudete* Sunday, the third Sunday of Advent. It is a day to rejoice, to be joyful because the day of Christmas is very close now. St. Thomas Aquinas taught that joy is the delight of the soul in the possession of a present good. It is a state of the soul and "the noblest human act."

We are getting closer to the beautiful feast of Christmas, the Church relaxes its penitential season for one day. The rose candle is lit, rose vestments are worn and flowers are permitted in Church for the day. By the way, the color is rose not pink, pink is not a liturgical color, it may look pink, but it is rose!

So today the emphasis changes in the Season of Advent now are to get ready for Christ's first coming to us as man on Christmas. We can now light our lights, decorate our houses and begin the festivities. That is of course if you haven't started since Halloween.

And as much time we spend getting ready for Santa and Rudolf, baking our cookies, telling Santa what we want, we are to prepare now spiritually for Christmas. And the best way spiritually to prepare for Christmas is by going to confession.

Tomorrow is **Reconciliation Monday**. A few years ago, the Archdiocese of New York along with the Diocese of Brooklyn started Reconciliation Monday during Advent and Lent in every Catholic Church from 3PM - 8PM. You can go to confession in any Catholic Church near your work or school. The children in our school and PREP program have already received the sacrament this past week, now it is the adults' time.

Sadly, the sacrament of Confession has lost its importance these past 40 years. We as a society have lost our sense of sin, offending God. We are killing off our consciences, our moral judgment. We are justifying our bad behavior on society or our upbringing. People don't see the consequences of their actions or their bad effects on other peoples' lives. We have become a "me" society, it's all about ME. Even to the point that I am my own judge.

The sacrament of Penance is a most beautiful sacrament. It is not only a sacrament of forgiveness, I think today more importantly it is a sacrament of healing. We are healed in this sacrament from the wounds that are caused by sins. People carry around within them sins of their past that they were never healed of and like a disease it just eats away at them. They just never let it go. There are two extremes: people sadly convinced themselves that they can never be forgiven, and those who presume God's forgiveness without asking. There is no sin that cannot be forgiven if one asks God. God never gets tired of forgiving us.

If it has been years since you experienced the forgiveness and healing of God, now is the time. In every confessional, there are two options, one can stay anonymous and kneel behind the screen, or one can confess face to face, it is your choice. However, know that in confession the priest does not know you, cannot act on any information given in confession, and can never reveal even the fact that you went to confession. Tell the priest how long it has been and ask him to help you make a good confession. Never feel embarrassed to confess your sins. It is the most inviolate secret in the world. Very quickly in the priesthood, a priest hears every sin possible. People are not that creative, there are no new sins.


Confessions will be heard here from 3:00 until 8:00 PM on Monday, December 18th.
The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the altar for private prayer as well.

In this season of joy, we should pray that God open our hearts to the joy of forgiveness. The more we recognize the importance of joy and seek it, the more we will find it.

- for a Special Intention:

-Special Intention Cards are for a living person and are obtained for a number of reasons: general good wishes, birthdays, anniversaries, return to good health, in thanksgiving, or for a particular need or moment in the life of another, e.g. a new home.

There are two types of Mass Cards:

-An “**Announced Mass**” means that the Mass will be celebrated on a certain day at a scheduled Mass time when the priest announces the intention to the congregation and it is printed in the weekly parish bulletin.

-An “**Unannounced Mass**” refers to a Mass when the intention is remembered by one of the priests at a Mass that has no announced intention.
