From the Desk of Father Raaser

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of *Pentecost* (Greek=fiftieth), an important Jewish and Christian feast. The Jewish feast of Pentecost, in Hebrew Shavuot, also known as the Feast of Weeks: 7 days a week multiplied by 7 weeks, plus one more day=50 days-Pentecost). It was the first feast allowed to be celebrated after Passover. It was one of the three ancient Jewish pilgrimage festivals, in which all males had to walk to the Temple at Jerusalem to offer thanksgiving to God for the success of the harvest.

On the Pentecost after the resurrection of Jesus (50 days from the Passover in which He was crucified), the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles and Our Lady in the form of tongues of fire accompanied by the sound of a rush of wind. The Spirit of God was given and they had the power of speaking in such a way that people of different languages could understand them. A new harvest was about to take place! This feast of Pentecost is a commemoration of this event, and it is solemnly observed as the birthday of the Church and the feast of the Holy Spirit.

To celebrate the Feast, please come downstairs to Toner Hall after the 7:30, 9:00 or 10:30 AM Mass for a Pancake breakfast hosted by the Knights of Columbus.

WELCOME HOME

It is good to see many of our college students returning home for the summer from their schools. It is good to have you back with us. Some of them look very good, others need to have their Mom's home cooked meals, still others need to make up for their lack of sleep (due to all those hours of studying, of course!). I hope all of our students have a restful summer with their families. It is always good to be back home.

RENEW AND REBUILD

This weekend we are kicking off our Parish Capital Improvement campaign: **Renew and Rebuild**. Our parish goal is \$1.475 million. 74% of the monies collected stay right here in St. Margaret's Parish. 26% of the monies collected help our fellow Catholics in the Archdiocese of New York. On the cover of the bulletin are the initiatives and goals for our campaign. Our buildings need to be renewed. These goals can be accomplished. We have already 49% of the goal reached with only 61 parishioners! Thank you—4% of our parish. I know the other 96% of our parishioners want to help. No amount is too small or great. Our parish is our second home. The church has always been known as a home. In fact, the early Christians met in private homes before Emperor Constantine gave over some of the municipal buildings in Rome to be used for the gathering of the Christians. Even our parish started in the Samuelson house on Ridge St. back in 1893.

We are inheritors of this parish; our parents and grandparents built our Church in 1931, our school in 1953 and the annex in 1959 along with the convent, now the Parish Center. It is up to our generation to keep these buildings renewed for our children and their children.

We have great needs to maintain our patrimony.

You have been so generous in up keeping our parish. I am asking for all to help. I am hoping that we can reach our goal by June. I will certainly keep you informed by the weekly bulletin and the parish website of our progress. You will receive letters from me asking you to pledge a certain amount over 5 years.

I don't know your financial situation, so what you can do in a sacrificial way is greatly appreciated. A pledge is not a binding document; if your financial situation changes over the years, be prudent, do what makes sense.

Those who pledge \$10,000 or higher will have a naming opportunity in the Church and school, and residence.

MASS CARDS The giving of a "Mass Card" to an individual or a family is a traditional and honored custom of the Catholic Community.

Mass Cards can be given or sent for:

-the repose of the soul of a deceased person or
 -for a Special Intention:

-Special Intention Cards are for a living person and are obtained for a number of reasons: general good wishes, birthdays, anniversaries, return to good health, in thanksgiving, or for a particular need or moment in the life of another, e.g. a new home.

There are two types of Mass Cards:

-An "Announced Mass" means that the Mass will be celebrated on a certain day at a scheduled Mass time when the priest announces the intention to the congregation and it is printed in the weekly parish bulletin.

-An "Unannounced Mass" refers to a Mass when the intention is remembered by one of the priests at a Mass that has no announced intention.

Mass cards may be obtained at the Parish Center during regular office hours – (9 AM – 4:30 PM, Mon. - Fri.).
