From the Desk of Father Raaser

They call it a mystery, in fact the greatest mystery there is. Volumes that fill libraries have been written about it, the greatest minds that have ever lived couldn't figure it out, still can't. It is the Most Blessed Trinity, our God, the one true God in Three Divine Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, equal in majesty, undivided yet distinct. Confused yet? The most heresies in the history of the Church concerned this mystery, in trying to talk about it, one falls very quickly into error.

It is the most central tenet of our faith. It is something that should not be a stumbling block to faith, rather a proof for God's existence. Mysteries in a religion point to something divine, the more mysteries the better. Simply, if man created a mystery, then another person would have figured it out by now, for there is always someone better in thought, word or deed. But the divine mysteries can't be figured out, for they are a-logical, beyond the logic of our human minds, we can't arrive at them, or fully understand them. God must reveal them to us. And so God revealed the Blessed Trinity to us through Christ His Son. So the best we can do is to find an analogy to try to explain this mystery of God.

There have been many analogies in trying to explain the Trinity. We see the number three in many things, particularly in relationships: knowledge, known, knower: memory, understanding, will: the shamrock: the triangle, etc.

The analogy I like best is: the beloved, the lover and love. For St. John teaches us that GOD IS LOVE. God is seen as a community of love, God is not solitary. God is a communion of persons who perfectly communicate with one another and perfectly support one another. And we, who are created in the image and likeness of God, are the same way. We are made for community and relationships. And the most fundamental community of love is found in a family, in the love of husband and wife, and the power of their love creates a new life, a new love, namely, their children.

In the Sacrament of Marriage, the Triune God is so wonderfully reflected in the love of a husband and wife and their children. There are so many attacks on marriage and family life today, we must return to a family life, if our society is to get better.

Also, I would like to congratulate our 124 young parishioners who received the Sacrament of Confirmation this month. Thank you to Bishop Walsh, to their grandparents, parents, sponsors, their teachers and catechists, especially Mrs. Lattuca, Mrs. Horgan and Mrs. Maldonado.

Finally, tomorrow is Memorial Day-the day we remember and pray for those men and women who gave up their lives for us and our freedoms. I would like to acknowledge their families who had their sons and daughters, our brothers and sisters sacrifice their lives.

Every American ought to recognize this day out of their patriotic duty to their country and in honor of those who shed their blood to make America what she is today--free, strong, and still a nation worth fighting for.

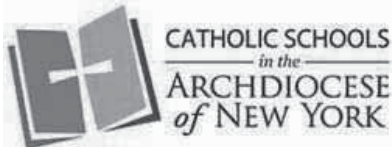
